



# How to Play Guide: Guess Who? Mitten Edition

Players: 2

Do you know who represents us at the local, state, and national level? Put your skills to the test with this special edition of Guess Who!

Step 1: Cut out all the cards from their worksheets

Step 2: Set up a tall barrier between players (like a row of books or a box) to keep opponents from seeing the cards

Step 3: Shuffle the cards and then lay out each set of player cards (blue and red) in four rows of six faces each, place the green cards into a pile to the side of the playing area.

Step 4: Playing the Game:

Each play picks a face card from the green pile, placing it in front of them. After determining who goes first, the active player gets to ask one question from their opponent.

- Questions like “Man or Woman?” or “Local or state?” are great to start out with

If the opponent answers the question positively, the player then flips over all the cards that don't fit the criteria (i.e. if the opponent has a woman, all male cards are to be flipped over).

Players take turns asking questions until the opponent's person has been guessed. A correct guess means a win!

- The active player may guess who the opponent's person is any time they are actively playing.
