



How to Play Guide: Go A'Courtin' Card Game

Players: 2 to 4

Number of Pairs Available: 40

Do you have what it takes to match the judge to their court? The player with the most pairs wins the game!

Step 1: Cut out all the cards from their worksheets

Step 2: Shuffle the cards

Step 3: Deal 8 cards (face down) to each player and put the remainder into a pile in the center of the playing area.

Step 4: Playing the Game:

The first player is the person to left of the dealer (or the non-dealer if only two players) and they can ask any person at the table if they have a card they are searching for (ex. "Do you have a Family Court Judge?").

If their opponent doesn't have the asked-for card, they tell the player to "Go A-Courtin'!" and they should pull the top card from the pile in the center of the playing area.

If their opponent does have the card, it should be handed over to the player who will set aside their pairing. The player continues their turn until they are told to "Go A-Courtin'!"

The game play continues until all cards have been played and the player with the most cards wins the game.
